## Mayo Clinic Appeals Decision Over the Estate of Herman C. Stille

Leadership at Floyd County Medical Center (FCMC) learned on Thursday, July 3, 2025, that the Mayo Clinic has filed a notice of appeal in the matter of the estate of Herman C. Stille.

The First Judicial Court of Iowa ruled in favor of FCMC in early June, saying that FCMC fulfilled the conditions of Mr. Stille's will to build a cancer center in Charles City.

FCMC was set to receive \$10 million from Mr. Stille's estate. The appeal will likely prolong the process to build a cancer center, as well as incur more legal expenses for FCMC.

Despite this setback, FCMC remains committed to bringing the vision of providing oncology services in north Iowa to life.

"While we are very disappointed with this action, FCMC will continue to work on fulfilling what we believe is Mr. Herman Stille's intent: to provide quality oncology care to the communities we serve through establishing a cancer center at FCMC," said Dawnett Willis, MBA, chief executive officer at FCMC.
